REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Be a graduating senior at a Chicago or suburban public high school.
- Submit official high school transcripts.
- Submit A.C.T. / S.A.T. Scores.
- Complete an Application Profile (see page 4 of application).
- Submit a typewritten persuasive essay (450 to 500 words maximum) on the following topic:

"What are your most important extracurricular activities or community service? What made you begin these activities?" What made you continue them? Also, please refer to the Essay Format Guidelines for more information.

- Supply two (2) letters of recommendation. The letters of recommendation shall attest to the applicant's character and commitment to higher education. We recommend both come from your referring institution, but at least one from your referring institution.
- Submit an official acceptance letter from an accredited four year college or university.

AWARD

Four scholars may be selected. Each selected scholar will receive an award of \$500.

ESSAY FORMAT GUIDELINES

Essays submitted with this application must adhere to the following format guidelines:

1. The name of the applicant, name of applicant's high school, and date of the essay must appear **single-spaced** in the upper left-hand corner of the first page of the essay;
2. The title of the essay must be centered above the body of the essay and below the name, high school, and date of essay;
3. Essays must be typewritten in Times New Roman 12 point font;
4. The body of the essay must be **double-spaced** with the first line of each new paragraph indented no more than one half inch (1/2");
5. The top and bottom margins must be set to one inch (1");
6. The left and right margins must be set to one inch (1"); and
7. The length of the essay must be between 450 to 500 words;

Failure to adhere to all guidelines set forth herein may result in an applicant's disqualification.

The following is a sample of the layout and format expected of all essay submissions:

Title of Essay

The body of the essay shall begin here. The body of the essay must be double-spaced with the first line of each new paragraph indented no more than one half inch (1/2"). The top and bottom page margins must be set to one inch (1"). The left and right margins must be set to one inch (1"). The font must be Times New Roman 12 point font. The length of the essay must be between 450 to 500 words.

Applicants are advised that elements of the essay evaluation criteria include (but are not limited to): grammar, punctuation, capitalization, spelling, diction, and sentence structure. Additionally, applicants are advised that other elements of the essay evaluation criteria include (but are not limited to): presence of a clearly-stated thesis, well-developed paragraphs, adherence to the topic, persuasiveness of the argument, and a strong conclusion.
